Did you know that you can claim back 33% of your School Donations?

Sacred Heart College relies on school donations to help pay for additional staffing and resources that aren't covered by government funding. We understand that we are in a tough economic climate, but we truly appreciate all contributions we receive from our families.

School donations are tax-deductible, for example, if you donate \$360, you could get \$118.80 back from the IRD at the end of the financial year.

Your donation helps us provide better resources and opportunities for our students, and you can get a third of it back.

Who can claim?

Anyone who:

- Is a New Zealand tax resident
- Earned taxable income during the year
- Donated \$5 or more to an approved organisation, including Sacred Heart College.

How to claim your 33% back:

- Keep your donation receipt from the school we will send these out after 1 April specifically for this purpose.
- 2. Log in to your myIR account at www.ird.govt.nz
- 3. Go to 'Donation Tax Credit' and upload your receipt, and you have completed your claim.

You have 4 years to claim your donation tax credit.
